The Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Committee will present a seminar entitled ***“Luzerne County: How It Happened and How It Can Never Happen Again”*** on **Wednesday, August 11, 2010**. The speaker will be Senior Judge Arthur E. Grim, who was appointed by the Pennsylvania Supreme Court to review thousands of Luzerne County juvenile cases and determine remedies for those juveniles harmed in the \$2.6 million kickback scandal. He will discuss his findings, why he made the recommendations that he did and what measures need to be followed to prevent a similar scandal in the future. The ethical responsibilities of the bench and bar will be examined.
